Your role in the community is crucial. Talk to your relatives and loved ones about the importance of cancer screening. No screening is recommended, but if you are having symptoms, discuss these with your health care provider. No screening is recommended, but if you are having COLORECTAL symptoms, discuss these with your health care provider. •• HPV vaccination is recommended for all people ages 13-26 HPV who haven't been vaccinated or who have not completed . the vaccination series. The HPV vaccine is recommended for some adults ages 27-45 who are not adequately vaccinated. The vaccine should be given before exposure to HPV through sexual contact. The Hepatitis B vaccine protects infants, children, and adults from Hepatitis B. Talk to your health care provider.
