- Caregivers and support people



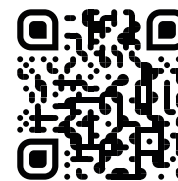
HOW IT HELPS

- Sign up now - getting started is simple and only takes a few minutes. You can use a desktop, laptop, tablet, or cell phone to access your community at any time.
- Your family can see when you need a ride, meal, or help—without lots of phone calls
- Share updates easily- post health updates once instead of repeating the same message to many people.
- Create your own private community- Add or remove family, friends, and caregivers. You can even give admin abilities to others to do this for you.
- Because your care is more than your medical journey, this platform connects you to your community for support with food, childcare, and daily life needs.
